Brooklyn Dodger, Jackie Robinson stops short after rounding 3rd during the third game of the World Series. Jack Roosevelt Robinson (1919-1972), the first black man to "officially" play in the big leagues in the 20th Century, possessed enormous physical talent and a fierce determination to succeed. In the course of a distinguished 10-year career beginning in 1947, Robinson led the Brooklyn Dodgers to six National League titles and one victorious World Series. Beyond his many stellar baseball feats, Jackie Robinson went on to champion the cause of civil rights when he retired from the game.
