Joan Miró (Spanish/French, 1893 - 1983) "Ma de Proverbis" (1970) (Handmade Proverbs) is a limited edition color lithograph on Guarro paper. It is plate signed in lower right, pencil signed in the lower left, and numbered 15/100 in the lower right. It measures 21.25" x 28" framed under mat and glass. Ships free in the USA. Ma de Proverbis (M. 673-679) consists of seven lithographs in color, created in 1970, on Arches paper, each signed and numbered in pencil, (the total edition was 105), printed by Maeght, Paris, published by Polígrafa, Barcelona, printed close to the sheet edges, each with a deckle edge at the bottom. • Published by Ediciones Polígrafa, Spain.
