THE NAUPAKA.

The Naupaka is a low spreading shrub, with thick and succulent and fleshy leaves. It is always found close to the sea, often within reach of the waves. In sheltered situations it attains a height of five or six feet, but generally it is not more than three feet high. It bears the "scenting" buds of summer in a wonderful manner, and in the winter months may be seen with bright green foliage, when most other plants are bare and brown; thus giving the lonely seacoast where it grows, a fresh, pleasant appearance.

The flowers and berries are not by any means conspicuous, but are quite pretty when examined closely.
