### THE NEHE

*Aster multiflorus*, A. Gray, var.

The Nehe was a very common plant a few years ago. Now it is nearly found in any spot that is suitable to culture. It is a spreading, bushy plant, three or four feet high, bearing quantities of yellow flowers all through spring and summer.

Although it grows rapidly at home on low or high land, yet, when growing upon the prairies, the flowers are much larger, brighter colored, and stand in more show, than those found near the river. The present representation was painted about three thousand feet above the sea level, by those who have only seen the plant near the coast, might have another species, but in making it to be true.

The leaves of the nehe are sometimes used like the common one, by both Europeans and natives, and have either a pleasant flavor, besides possessing it in kind, some medicinal value.
