Description

Marcel Janco (1895-1984, Romania/Israel) - "TABLE WITH FRUIT" (1974) is a color lithograph. It is pencil signed in the lower right, titled in French "Table aux fruits" in the lower left, and numbered 144/200 in the lower center. It was printed by Mambush Ein-Hod Israel with blind stamp in the lower right. The image measures 16 $\frac{3}{4}$ x 23 $\frac{3}{4}$ " with full margins, and framed, the piece is 28" x 37."

In 1910-14 he exhibited at the salons in Bucharest and moved among modernist artists and poets. In 1916, while studying architecture, he was among the founders of Dada in Zurich. There he participated in the famous evenings at Café Voltaire where he was in charge of the stage and costume design. In the 1920s he was much involved in the Dada movement. He had ties with the Paris branch, participating there
