Enrico Baj (1924-2003, Italian) "Der Kleine General" (The Little General) - Intaglio lithograph in 10 colors, signed in pencil, numbered 5723/10,000. The image measures 10" x 6.25", full margins and the piece has been double matted and framed measuring a total of 24.5" x 20.5." Shipping is free in the USA. Enrico Baj, was an Italian painter, sculptor, art theorist, (and anarchist?) He worked primarily in collage, prints, and sculptures. He is considered to be part of the surrealist, Dada and Cobra movements. Also a writer, he was associated the avante-garde movement. Originally influenced by Matisse, he was also known to borrow heavily from artists such as da Vinci and Picasso. Enrico Baj left Italy during World War 2 in order to avoid conscription. Baj often found himself at odds with the militarism of the era, and frequently clashed with the political and military leadership of Italy. He later created his most famous work, the Generals Series, from articles which he had found. E
