Al Hirschfeld (1903 – 2003, American Caricaturist) "The Dybbuk" is an offset lithograph on paper measuring 15.5 x 12.25 in. (sight), and 20.5" x 24.5" (framed.) THE DYBBUK starring CAROL LAWRENCE, THEODORE BIKEL AND LUDWIG DONATH was the play of the week (10/3/60). A small amount of water damage exists on the very bottom of the work (not in the art), and it was carefully framed to conceal that. Shipping is free in the USA. In Jewish mythology, a dybbuk is a malicious possessing spirit believed to be the dislocated soul of a dead person. It supposedly leaves the host body once it has accomplished its goal, sometimes after being helped. Directing legend Sidney Lumet, of course, began his career in the Golden Age of American television, with a number of live broadcasts that featured prominent screen and television actors.
