An expedition of Russian troops, observing the British Expeditionary Force, has been ordered to disband. In the course of its march it reached the Russian frontier near the great Russian fortress of Przenya, in Galicia, the last of which was captured in March. The scene in the drawing was taken with its staff, the Russian General-in-Chief, Captain R. S. Paget, and a Russian

officer. The trees of Przenya, seen in the distance through the trees, are in a mountainous region, through which the British Expeditionary Force is marching. Between the trees and the point where the group are standing, the Russian troops are with their rifles in their hands. The scene was taken by Sir Arthur Paget, and a Russian
